Topic –**Laws Related To LGBTQIA+**

Round 1

The first round of the competition involves the written submission. The participants will be required to submit a written draft about the amendments they are proposing. A panel of Judges will review the submissions and hold the right to select and reject them.

Submission Guidelines (Round 1)

- The submission should be original work.
- The written submissions should be of a maximum of 1000 words.
- Citations can be included as endnotes.
- The body of the submission must be in Times New Roman, Font Size: 12, and with 1.5 line spacing.
- The main text of the Submission should be justified.
- The submissions shall not contain the name of the participants. The name of the participant should be provided in a separate cover letter.
- Plagiarism should not be more than 10%.
- The submissions must be sent in one of the following prescribed format: Ms word

National Amendment Writing Competition

Guidelines

Topic –Laws Related To LGBTQIA+

Format of the Written Document

- Title
- Identification of Chapter/Article you want to amend
- Arguments and reasoning
- Conclusion

Round 2

Based on the marks obtained in the first round, 10 written drafts will be selected for the second round that is the oral round. The oral round would be hosted on an online platform. Each participant will be given 10 minutes, out of which 4 minutes will be allotted for the opening statement by the participant, and the remaining six minutes are saved for the question-answer round by a panel of judges. The participants will be judged on how comprehensively they bring out their analogy for the amendment proposed and on the basis of their answers to the questions raised by the judges.

- 2.The language of scripts can be either Hindi, English, or both.
- 3.The topic of your podcast must be related to Pride month (LGBTQIA+)

- 5.After the selection of your script you will receive a mail regarding the recording guidelines.
- 6.It is as per the organizers to decide the changes in the script.

 - b) Facts
 - c) Plagiarism
 - d) Originality
