Theme

The theme of the competition is "Ground Water: Making the Invisible Visible" and participants are free to choose any of the following sub-themes:

- 1. National Water Policy, 2002 and Drinking Water Issues.
- 2. Universal access to safe and affordable drinking water by 2030.
- 3. Role of Institutions, Infrastructure and Technology in meeting Global Water Challenges.
- 4. Right to Water and International Law Instruments.
- 5. Interstate rivers: Management, Development and Dispute Resolution.

These themes are merely suggestive and submissions on another topic within the purview of the theme will be accepted.

Eligibility

• Eligibility: Students, pursuing undergraduate or postgraduate programs in recognized law schools in India; research scholars, legal professionals and other interested candidates are eligible to participate. Co-authorship is not permitted.

Submission Guidelines

- The manuscript should be in MS Word format. Submission in any other format will not be accepted.
- The title of the manuscript should be concise and apt to the chosen topic.
- Word limit of the article should be 1800-2500 words, inclusive of footnotes.
- The manuscript shall be original and unpublished. Plagiarism must be within the permissible limit of 20%.
- The submission should not be plagiarized and should be free from grammatical, spelling, and other errors.
- Full name of the author must be given.
- A uniform method of citation must be adhered to (Bluebook 20th edition).
- The body of the manuscript shall be in Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.5 line spacing. Footnotes should be in Times New Roman, size 10, single line spacing.
- A margin of 4 cm shall be left on all sides of the paper.
- Page borders shall not be used.

Awards

- The participants will be provided with E-Certificates of participation.
- The authors of the three best articles will be awarded with a publication in Volume 1, Issue 3 of the Legal Lock Journal (ISSN no. 2583-0384).
