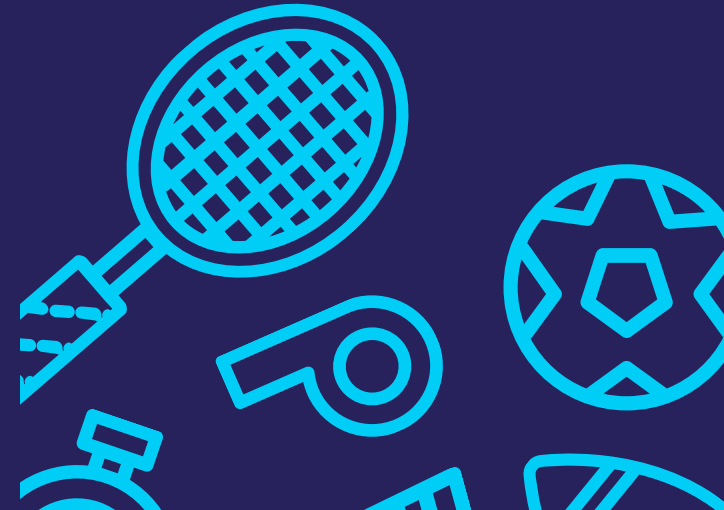

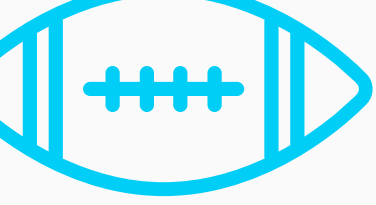

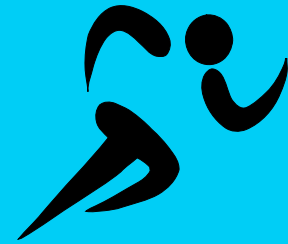


ABOUT SPORTS LAW

Submissions made without an abstract shall be outrightly rejected.
