ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) was set up by an Act of Parliament and notified on 19th July 1973. The objectives of the University, as laid down in the act, are "to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit; to pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions with aim to provide welfare of the people of the hill areas of the North-Eastern region, and in particular, the intellectual, academic and cultural advancement". Despite constraints of communication and the lack of infrastructure facilities in the region, NEHU has established itself as an institution of higher learning and research of very high quality. NEHU has around 4500 students applying for various Master's, M.Phil and PhD degrees with a faculty strength of over 500 members. There are sixty undergraduate colleges affiliated with the University, including ten professional colleges with about 20,000 students. Thus, in nearly 50 years, NEHU has matured into an institution with a serious academic, social and cultural agenda with a clear vision for its future growth. Recently NEHU ranked 66th in the NIRF 2022 survey by MHRD Govt. of India.
