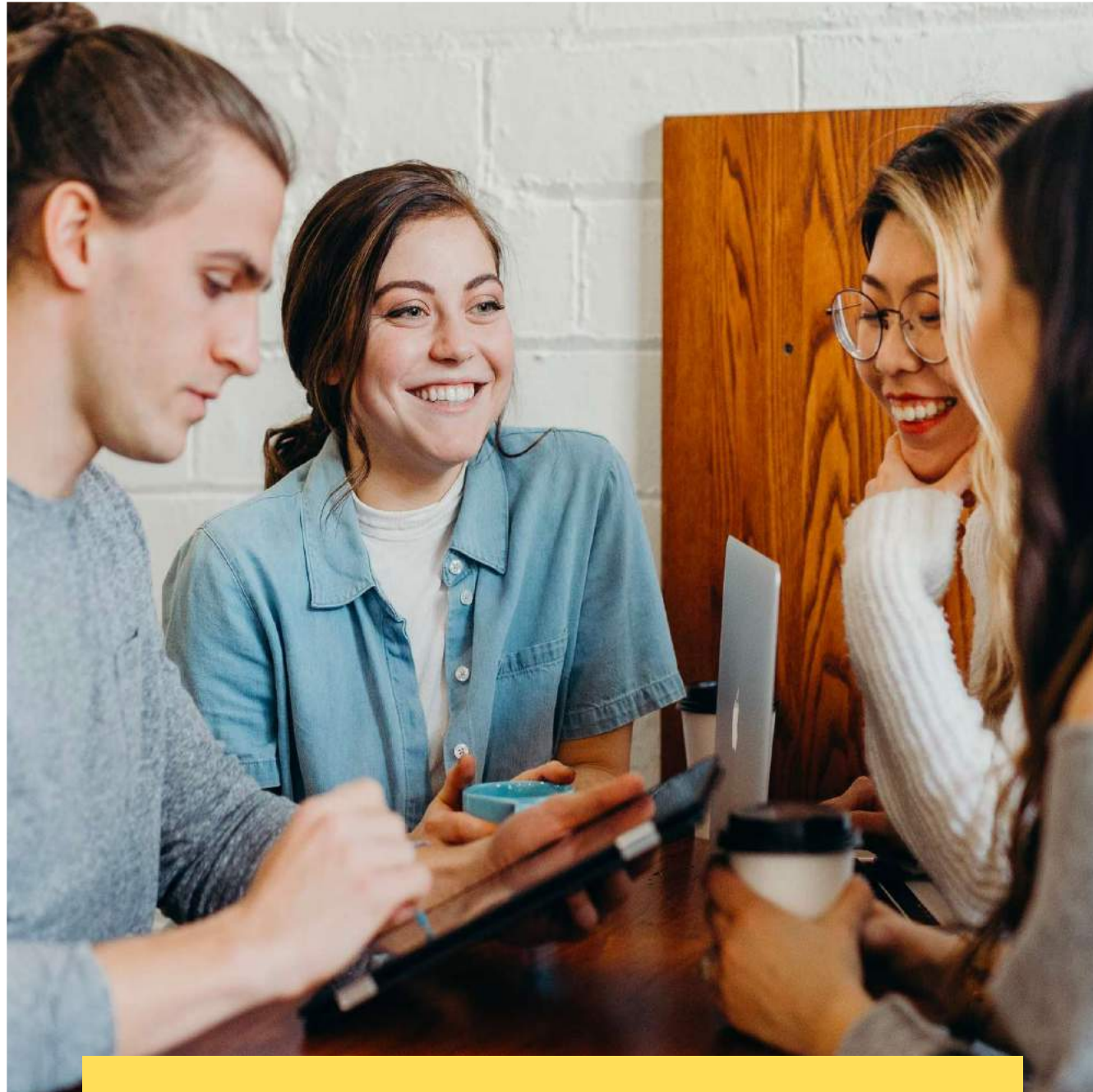

United Nations Development Programme (**UNDP**) is also known as the United Nations global development network. It is primarily concerned with achieving the eradication of poverty, reducing inequalities and exclusion, helping developing and least developed countries to formulate policies, leadership skills, partnering abilities, institutional capabilities and building resilience in order to achieve sustainable development according to the **17** Sustainable Development Goals. **UNDP** is also helping countries to have proper aid utilisation, and also promoting inclusion.

### VISA:

IMUN will provide the **necessary documents** to support your **visa** application on request but not responsible for your **Visa** into **Indonesia**. It is your responsibility to secure the necessary documents to enter Indonesia.

### CANCELLATION POLICY:

If the event is canceled by the organizer, you will receive a **full refund (100%)**. If you cancel your participation in the event for any reason, you receive **no refunds**.
