ABOUT DEBATE AND DISCUSSIONS SOCIETY



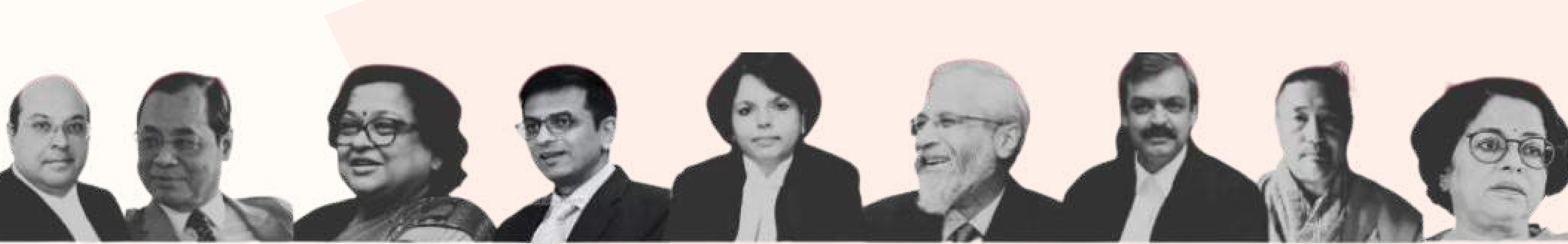

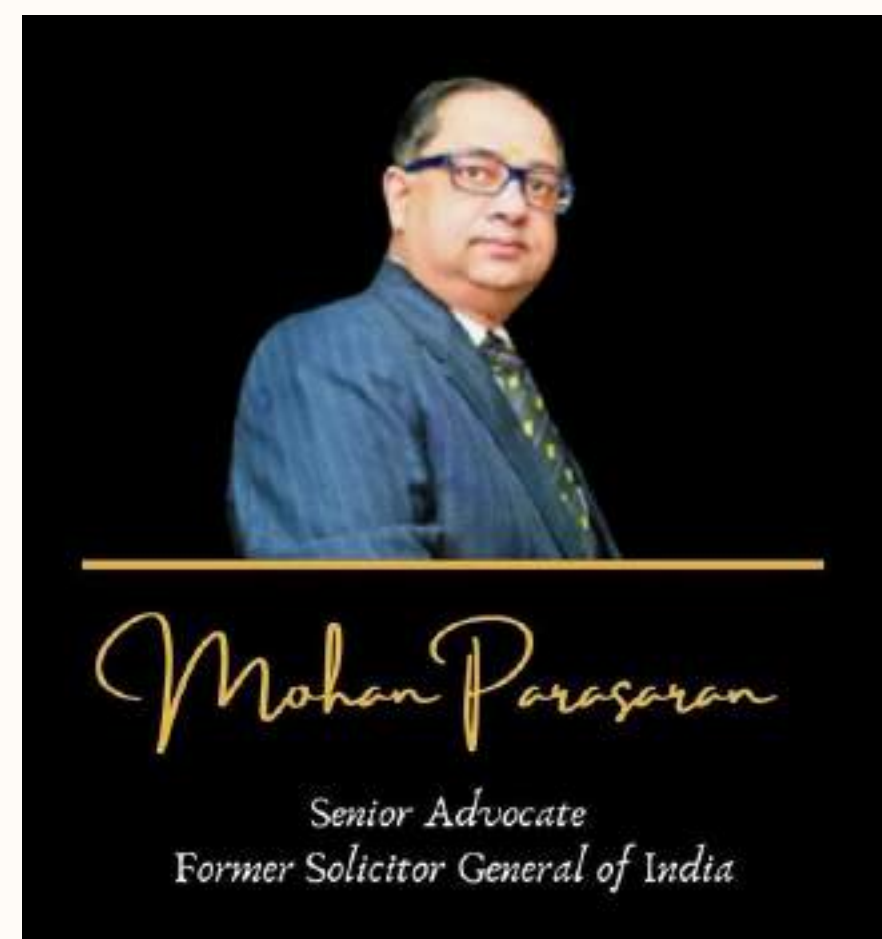
Courtroom legends is an initiative by DDS, where students get to learn and interact with Legendary Counsels who have mastered the craft of advocacy.



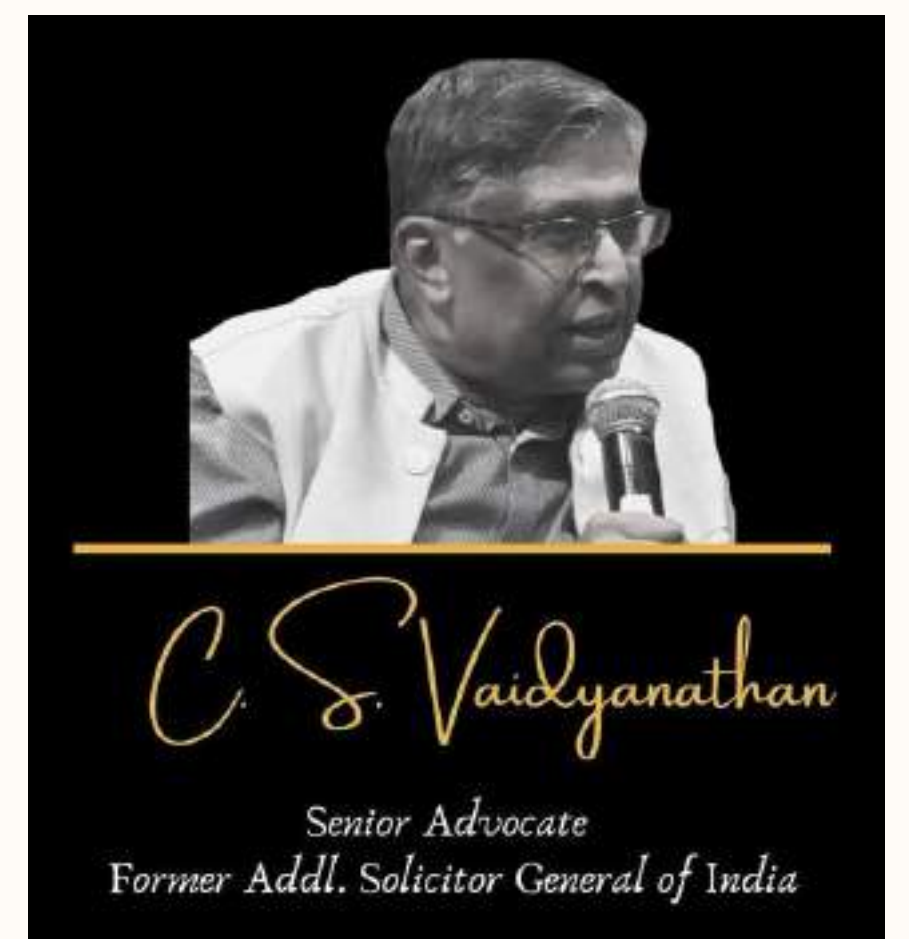




